Fences 2'6 to 2'9 with option jumps to 3'0. Derby consists of two rounds with the top 12 horses from the first round called back for the second handy hunter round. Order of go will be emailed 6pm Fri, and any adds after that will ride at the top of the order. Special ribbons for rounds one and two, and neck rosettes for places 1-12 in overall competition. Special prize to derby winner. See NTHJC Rule Book for full description and scoring. No schooling, but riders may walk the course. Entry fee \$55. Must have 14 horses for Derby to make.

### Rules and Information

1. The entry fee is \$20 per class, or \$25 per class if entries are received **after 10 pm Wednesday** prior to the show. There will be an office/ NTHJC scholarship fee of \$20 for each horse/rider combination, and a non-member fee of \$20 for riders who are not members of NTHJC. There will also be a \$5 paramedic fee per horse/rider combination per day. Fees will be paid at the registration desk by either cash or check.
2. Warm-up classes are open to all. **NOTE: It may be necessary to cancel one or more of the warm-up classes if there are so many entries in the show that our ability to complete every division becomes threatened.**
3. Riders must wear ASTM/SEI Helmets at all times while mounted.
4. Proof of a negative Coggins report within one year is required by the State of Texas. Please e-mail copies of Coggins report with entries.
5. A horse/rider combination may only cross-enter into hunter divisions with fence heights of no more than 6" difference, except the limit divisions. This includes eq flat and under saddle classes. Limit riders may not enter higher than 2'0 classes.
6. All children must be accompanied **and** supervised by an adult.
7. **Dogs must be kept on a leash held in hand at all times.**
8. Management reserves the right to change, cancel, or combine classes, alter courses, and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries.
9. Medal classes are open to all Jr/Amateur riders, but only NTHJC members are eligible to compete in the Year End Medal Finals.
10. Awards will include a prize for first place and 1<sup>st</sup> thru 6<sup>th</sup> place ribbons for each class. Champion and Reserve ribbons, and a prize for champion will be awarded for each division. The Eq Over Fences, Eq on the Flat and NTHJC Medal Class will be considered a division at each height and a Champion/ Reserve ribbon and prize for champion will be given, provided all 3 classes are held.
11. All NTHJC recognized classes (except warm-up classes) with 20 or more competitors will be divided.
12. **There will be no concessions offered at this show.**
13. **\$1,000 NTHJC Hunter Derby:** Entry fee is \$55. See NTHJC Rule Book for full description and scoring. Prize money for top 6 places will be split as follows: **1st-\$300 2nd-\$220 3rd-\$150 4th-\$120 5th-\$110 6th-\$100** **There must be 14 horses entered for the derby to make.**
14. **HLF management asks that everyone on the show grounds honor the 6ft social distancing rule, and wear masks when sitting in groups if this distance cannot be maintained.**
  - Courses will not be posted **but will be included in show packets.**
  - Only trainers (or riders without trainers) will be allowed at registration desk; will provide checks and receive packets containing courses, back numbers, and strings. Phone numbers of staff at desk will be provided in show packets. Trainers will notify desk of adds and scratches. Notify desk before rider enters the arena, and please limit calls to the desk.
  - Trainers will close out checks. Other than trainers, only individuals without trainers should approach the desk to close out checks.
  - Masks are highly recommended for everyone at the show, especially when in close proximity to others.
  - Riders will pick up ribbons from tables located in the vicinity of the registration area, not at the gate.
  - Maintain six-foot social distancing.

**Consent Agreement and Liability Release –2020 Show Year**

I, \_\_\_\_\_, do for myself and/or on behalf of my minor child or legal ward, hereby voluntarily request to be permitted to come upon the property of Barbara Mims and Danny Mims (“Owners”) known as Hidden Lake Farm, for the purpose of general recreational activities and/or participation in horse shows and/or clinics for the period from January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020.

I am fully aware and understand that horses are unpredictable by nature; that when frightened or angry or under stress, a horse’s natural instincts are to jump forward or sideways, to run away from danger at a trot or gallop, to kick, to bite, to buck, or to rear up in front; that horses are extremely powerful; and that if a rider falls to the ground, the fall distance will be generally from 3-1/2 to 5-1/2 feet. I understand that I, or my minor child or legal ward, could be injured as a result of any of these or other actions of a horse. I understand these risks, and I voluntarily assume these risks and dangers.

I further understand that upon mounting a horse and taking up the reins, the rider is in primary control of the horse, and that Owners are not responsible for the results of the rider’s actions or inactions, for the actions of the horse, or for the actions or inactions of other show/clinic participants or their horses. I am aware that the wearing of an approved riding helmet can reduce the chance of injury to me and/or my minor child or legal ward and agree to wear such helmet at all times while mounted on a horse at Hidden Lake Farm.

I fully understand and agree that I alone am to be responsible for any bodily injury or property damage which I or my minor child or legal ward should sustain on the premises and/or trails of Hidden Lake Farm while engaged in general recreational activities and/or participation in horse shows and/or clinics, and for any time I or my child or legal ward should lose from employment or school or other activity, and for medical expenses or any other expenses incurred because of such bodily injury or property damage. **IN ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF THE ABOVE, I HEREBY, FOR MYSELF, MY HEIRS, ADMINISTRATORS AND ASSIGNS, RELEASE AND DISCHARGE AND AGREE TO HOLD HARMLESS OWNERS AND THEIR AGENTS, EMPLOYEES, CONTRACTORS AND/OR REPRESENTATIVES (INCLUDING ALL SHOW/CLINIC JUDGES, GATEKEEPERS AND OTHER STAFF) AND ALL OTHER SHOW/CLINIC PARTICIPANTS OF AND FROM ALL CLAIMS, DEMANDS, ACTIONS AND CAUSES OF ACTION FOR SUCH INJURIES SUSTAINED TO MY PERSON OR PROPERTY, OR TO THE PERSON OR PROPERTY OF MY MINOR CHILD OR LEGAL WARD, AND FROM SICKNESS OR DISEASE (INCLUDING COMMUNICABLE DISEASE), WHETHER OR NOT SUCH INJURY, SICKNESS, OR PROPERTY DAMAGE RESULTED FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OR GROSS NEGLIGENCE OF OWNERS OR THEIR RESPECTIVE AGENTS, EMPLOYEES, CONTRACTORS AND/OR REPRESENTATIVES, OR RESULTED FROM ANY DEFECT IN EQUIPMENT THAT MIGHT BE USED AROUND A HORSE, OR RESULTED FROM ANY CONDITION IN THE PREMISES AT HIDDEN LAKE FARM.**

I understand and agree that, in exchange for being permitted to participate in general recreational activities and/or participation in horse shows and/or clinics at Hidden Lake Farm for the period from January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020, I am voluntarily assuming the risks of any injury or property damage that might occur for **ANY REASON** and acknowledge my agreement that I may not bring a lawsuit or a claim of any kind against Owners and/or their respective agents, employees, contractors and/or representatives (including all show/clinic judges, gatekeepers and other staff) for such injuries and/or property damage. If I should bring such claim or lawsuit in violation of this agreement, I agree that I shall be liable to Owners for any and all reasonable attorneys’ fees and expenses that may be incurred by Owners in defending against such claims.

**I FURTHER AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND REIMBURSE OWNERS AND/OR THEIR AGENTS, EMPLOYEES, CONTRACTORS AND/OR REPRESENTATIVES (INCLUDING ALL SHOW/CLINIC JUDGES, GATEKEEPERS AND OTHER STAFF) FROM AND FOR ANY INJURY AND/OR PROPERTY DAMAGE CAUSED TO ANY THIRD PERSON AS A RESULT OF ANY ACTION OR INACTION ON MY PART. THIS INDEMNIFICATION INCLUDES THE REASONABLE COST OF ATTORNEYS’ FEES AND EXPENSES INCURRED BY OWNERS IN DEFENDING AGAINST ANY SUCH SUIT.**

I understand and agree that this Consent Agreement and Liability Release is being entered into in the State of Texas, and the laws of the State of Texas shall govern its terms and conditions. The parties agree that if any term or condition is found to be invalid under the laws of Texas, such offending term or condition shall be stricken from the Agreement without affecting the other terms and conditions.
