Office/ NTHJC Scholarship Fee: \$20.00 per rider/horse combination. Returned check \$25.00.

Any rider can compete in the NTHJC Medal classes and must follow the 6" cross entry rule when entering the Medal Classes, but only members will be eligible to compete in the Year End Medal Finals. The top 12 riders with the most points earned throughout the season will be invited to compete in the Medal Finals at the NTHJC Year End Show.

Protective approved hard hats must be worn at all times.

All classes will split when there are 20 entries except warm ups and derbies.

Proper show attire is required for all classes.

A horse/rider combination may only cross enter into divisions with fence heights of a six (6) inch difference, except the 18" Limit divisions are open to riders who begin the show season without having won 5 blue ribbons over fences. After winning 5 blue ribbons over fences, the rider may continue to compete in the division for the remainder of the show season. Limit Riders may not show in any classes over 2' at this show.

Jr/Am horse/Rider combinations may not cross enter into Open 2' and vis versa.

All headgear must meet or exceed ASTM standards and carry SEI tag. The helmet must be properly fastened protective headgear must be worn at all times by all rider when mounted anywhere on the show grounds.

All dogs must be on a leash in hand or confined.

Prospering Farm will be offering the **NTHJC High Point Thoroughbred Hunter & Jumper Awards**.

Ribbons: 1st - 6th Trophies to 1st. Championship & Reserve Championship ribbons to all divisions.

Mini Derbies: to enter the derbies the same pony/rider combination must have competed in the corresponding division at the show. The second hunter class of the division will be scored as the 1st round of the derby. All horses/ponies can return for the Derbies' 2nd round. **Mini Derby Fee is \$35.**

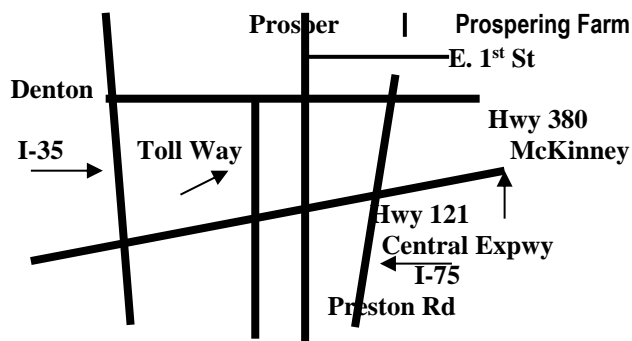
Please social distance at all times.
