****Please be familiar with the NTHJC Rules****

1. **Entry Fees and Deadlines:** The entry fee is \$15 per class if entries are called in by **Wed. May 12th** All entries received after 10 pm will be subject to a \$5 per class late fee. No phone entries please. Fax (214) 257-0646 or Email to: stonyglen@tx.rr.com or Julie@stonyglenstables.com
There is a \$5 NTHJC scholarship/office fee per horse/rider combination. There will be a \$15 fee added to all checks not closed out at the end of the day.
2. **Paramedic Fee:** A \$8 paramedic fee per show will be required for each horse/rider combination.– There will be 2 EMTs on site
3. **All trainers must be a current member of NTHJC and familiar with the NTHJC rules**
4. **NTHJC non-member fee \$20**
5. **Priority Ring:** The one minute rule will be enforced in the Priority Ring. Limit Classes always have priority.
6. **Eligibility:** The eligibility requirements for each division are specified on the prize list. In addition, horses may not cross enter into divisions with more than a 6" height difference (with the exception of limit classes). Horses and Riders in all **MEDAL classes** must be current NTHJC members.
7. **Warm Up Classes:** Warm Up classes are an option and do not count towards any points there will be no warm up classes for Jumper divisions.
8. **Schooling:** Daybreak to 20 minutes prior to start time and designated times on show bill. A warm up area will be available for schooling throughout the day.
9. **Changes:** Management reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes, alter courses and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate classes. Sections with less than three entries will be cancelled. Please check the boards for changes in the schedule. All NTHJC classes with 20 or more riders will be split.
10. **Attire:** Riders must be properly attired. ASTM/SEI Helmets must be worn while mounted. Correct rider numbers for the horse they are riding must be worn & clearly visible.
11. **Awards** will be given 1st-6th in all classes, champion and reserve for each Division. Prizes for champion, and 1st.
12. **Coggins:** A current Coggins dated within the last 12 months must be shown to the show secretary for each horse, to speed up check in time please fax coggins with show entries.
13. **Stalls:** Limited number of stalls can be reserved on a first come basis. Stall Fee \$35 (including shavings). To reserve a stall, mail a check to Stony Glen Stables 15117 Fishtrap Road, Aubrey Texas 76227

Directions

From 1-35 E go to Loop 288 and turn right (north) to Hwy 380. Go right (east) on Hwy 380 about 11 miles past 377 to FM 1385. Go left (north) on FM1385. 1/2 a mile take your first left onto Fishtrap.

From the Dallas North Toll way. Follow the toll way until the end at hwy 380, turn left (west) follow approx. 2.5 miles (through the light at Fm 423) take the next right (north) FM 1385. 1/2 a mile take your first left onto Fishtrap

From 75 go north to hwy 380, go Left (west) approx 13 miles to FM 1385. (Pass Preston, the toll way and Fm 423) Go north on 1385 .45 miles take your first left.
