USHJA Outreach Competitions provide the opportunity to earn national recognition in classes from walk/trot to 3'0" in Hunter and Equitation sections and .60m-1.20m in Jumper sections at rated and local shows.

Any rider may compete in Outreach Hunter, Jumper, and Equitation classes, but riders wishing to earn points and national recognition must be a USHJA free Outreach member or any other USHJA member category.

Show Rules & Information

ENTRIES: Please submit entries via http://www.horseshowsonline.com. Entry Closing Date: July 14th by 6pm.

LATE FEES: Entries submitted after the late deadline will be charged a \$25 late fee.

CLASS FEES: \$25 per class. Hunter Derby: \$50.

STALL FEES: \$115 each, from Friday-Sunday. Shavings: \$12/Bag (3 Minimum). Early Move-In or Late Move-Out available for \$35 per night, including tack stalls. Horse not renting a stall will be charged a grounds fee of \$45. Please request early move-in with the show secretary either via the online entry form with your entries, or via email to amy@equine-events.net and reservations@texasrosehorsepark.com.

SHOW FEES: Each horse/rider combination will be charged an EMT fee of \$10 per show. An EMT will be on grounds during posted schooling and show times. A \$15 office/\$10 NTHJC scholarship fee will be charged at \$25 per horse-rider combination. open check fee of \$15 will be charged for all accounts not closed at the show. Non-members of NTHJC will be charged a \$30 fee. A credit or debit card on file is required at the time of entry, but entry may be paid with check on the date of the show.

PRIZE MONEY: A W-9 form must be completed in full before any prize money will be paid. Prize money will be withheld if the recipients' Social Security number or EIN is not on file.

CREDIT CARDS: Credit cards WILL NOT be accepted at this show. Cash or check only. If paying with a check, it is required to have your Driver's License and date of birth noted on the check.

RETURNED CHECKS: A \$50 service fee or 10% of the amount (whichever is greater) will be charged for non-negotiable checks returned/disputed for any reason. Entries for future shows will be declined until funds are paid in full.

SHARPS DISPOSAL: Sharps containers will be provided in all barns for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments. ALL items of this nature MUST be disposed of in the provided containers. NO SHARPS are to be disposed of in any receptacle other than the provided sharps container. Any individual not in compliance will be subject to a \$100 fine.

REFUNDS: Stall fees will not be refunded after the closing date, July 14th, 2025, unless a certificate of illness or injury prepared by an accredited veterinarian or doctor's note regarding rider illness/injury, is presented to the secretary before the start of the show. In either case, stall fee will be refunded less the office fee of \$15.

SUBSTITUTION: With a vet's certificate, a new horse may be substituted for a show scratched horse if the scratched horse has not shown in any classes and both horses are registered under the same trainer. The scratched horse's stall fees are transferred to the substituted horse with no penalty or charge.

NON-SHOWING ENTRIES: Non-showing entries will be charged a \$40 schooling fee, in addition to show and stall or grounds fees. Non-showing entries are required to pay Office/Scholarship Fee and EMT Fee. All horses on the grounds must be registered in the show office and receive a back number.

USHJA OUTREACH PROGRAM: The show will be recognized by USHJA Outreach and qualify for USHJA Outreach points for Zone 7. To read more about the USHJA Outreach program and get your free membership, visit their website at: https://www.ushja.org/competition/outreach

NTHJC THOROUGHBRED HIGH POINT AWARDS: Entry is free. TB registered name or tattoo # is required. Entry must be completed on http://www.nthjc.com prior to the completion of the show. Thank you to **Oak View Equestrian** for sponsoring our High Point TB Awards.

COGGINS: Proof of a negative Coggins (EIA) within one year is required by state law. No entry will be accepted without a Copy of the Original Coggins test which may be emailed to <u>amy@equine-events.net</u> with entries or presented to the show office upon arrival. Includes non-showing entries.

ARENAS: RWB Ring: 180x300 Premier Equestrian Artificial mix footing. Fairfield Ring 135' x 300'. Indoor Arena 125x235. Both with sand composite footing. Footing quality is a priority and rings may be closed during inclement weather or for maintenance at any time during the show.

Show Rules & Information (cont.)

SCHOOLING: There will be open schooling in all rings Friday from 12:00PM until 6:00PM. Schooling available prior to ring start according to posted times on the schedule. No Jumper schooling on Saturday or Sunday.

LIMIT DIVISIONS: Limit divisions are open to riders who begin the show season without having won 5 blue ribbons over fences. After winning five (5) blue ribbons over fences the rider may continue to compete in this Division for the remainder of the show season. Warm up or Add Back blue ribbons will not count in the allowed Limit Blue Ribbons. Limit Riders may NOT show in any classes over 2'0 at this show.

CROSS ENTRIES: A horse/rider combination may cross enter only into divisions with fence heights of a 6" difference. Walk Trot Poles may only cross enter in Walk Trot Crossrails. Walk Trot Crossrails may only cross enter into Limit Beginner 18". Riders in Short Stirrup 18" may only cross enter into Limit Beginner 18". Riders competing in 2' Open Hunter may not cross enter into 2' Jr/Am Hunter.

AWARDS: All classes receive a first place Prize and 6 ribbons unless otherwise noted. A Champion ribbon & Prize and a Reserve Champion ribbon will be awarded for each division.

ATTIRE: Formal show attire is required in all classes. Jumper riders are permitted to wear polo shirts.

HELMETS: Properly fastened protective headgear must be worn at all times by all riders when mounted anywhere on show grounds. All headgear must meet or exceed ASTM standards, carry SEI tag and be properly fitted and secured by a harness.

DOGS: All dogs must be on a leash held in hand or confined.

CONCESSIONS: Concessions will be available during show hours.

SPLIT CLASSES: All classes, except warm-ups and specialty classes, with 20 or more entries will be split. Classes 18" and under will be split at 16 entries.

WARNING: Under Texas law (Chapter 87, Civil, Practice & Remedies Code), an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

RESPONSIBILITY NOTICE: Submission of entry to this show constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless NTHJC and show officials and management against any claim, demands, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fees for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of Exhibitor's business or its use of the premises or from any breach on the part of Exhibitors of any conditions of this Agreement, or contractors, agents, employees, guests, or invitees in or about the premises. In case of any action or proceeding brought against NTHJC and show management and officials by reason of any such claim. Exhibitor, upon notice, covenants to defend such action of proceeding by council acceptable to the owner. Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property and NTHJC and Show management are not responsible for accidents, fire, or theft.

SHOW MANAGEMENT: Management reserves the right to change, cancel, move or combine classes and do all things necessary in the best interests of the horse show and its operations.

PARKING: Fire regulations prohibit all vehicles, including trailers, vans, and passenger vehicles from being parked in the stable areas. Vans and trailers will be allowed in stable areas for loading and unloading only. Parking for vans and trailers is located next to the RV lot. **PARKING AREAS WILL BE DESIGNATED AND VIOLATORS WILL BE CHARGED WITH A \$200 NO PARKING FEE.**

OPERATION OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will **not** be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described vehicles so long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. **The parent, legal guardian, or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.**

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or legal guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

- From the south (Houston Area): take US 287 north to TX-155 towards Tyler. At FM-2661 turn left. Left again at TX-64, right on to CR-413, then left at FM-724. Follow FM-724 to CR-42 and turn right. At TX-110 turn left. The equestrian center is on the right.
- From the south (San Antonio Area): take I-35 north to US-84 and turn right. Follow US-84 to TX-31, turn right. At FM-314 turn left, right on to FM-279, left FM-1955 and then left on to TX-110. The equestrian center is on the right.
