ENTRIES: Entries will be done on horsespot.net or emailed to sbfshows@gmail.com. There will be a post entry fee of \$25 per horse/rider entry if entered after March 16th at 6:00 PM. No numbers will be issued without an open check, signed release and coggins.

CHECK OR CASH ONLY ACCEPTED- NO DIGITAL PAYMENT METHODS ACCEPTED

CLASS FEES: Individual classes are \$25 each.

STALLS: Limited stabling available on a first come, first serve basis. Stalls are available Friday-Sunday and are \$100 with shavings included. Please contact Tracey at 214-402-6472 to reserve stalls. Stalls must be prepaid the Monday before the show and are non-refundable unless otherwise filled or if the show is postponed due to rain.

SHOW FEES: \$25 office fee (\$15 office, \$10 scholarship) will be charged to for every horse & rider combination. EMT fee of \$10 per entry/per day. An open check fee of \$15 will be charged for all accounts not closed at the show. Non-showing entries will be charged a \$50 schooling/EMT fee.

MEMBERSHIP: All riders must be members of NTHJC for the current season. To join for 2026 please visit NTHJC.com

COGGINS: Proof of a negative Coggins (EIA) within one year is required by state law. No entry will be accepted without a current coggins within the last 12 months. Please add to Horse Spot entry or email to sbfshows@gmail.com

SCHOOLING: Friday Schooling- Ticketed schooling in both rings, times to be announced, no EMT will be present. Saturday Ring 1 schooling 6:30-7:30, ring 2 crossrail schooling daybreak-7:30, poles only schooling 7:30-7:45. Schooling may be available Saturday afternoon in both arenas once the courses are reset, time permitting. Sunday Ring 1 schooling 6:30-7:30am, Ring 2 schooling- daybreak to 7:45am.

AWARDS: All classes receive a first place Prize and 6 ribbons unless otherwise noted. A Champion ribbon & Prize and a Reserve Champion ribbon will be awarded for each division.



In case of any action or proceeding by council acceptable to owner. Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property and Spellbound Farm and NTHJC Management is not responsible for accidents, fire, or theft.

ARENAS: Ring 1: 135x250 covered arena with custom Kiser footing. Ring 2: 100x200 with sand footing. Warm-up areas are fenced grass paddocks.

ATTIRE: Formal show attire is required in all classes. Polo shirts are permitted in Jumpers. Peacock stirrups will not be allowed nor any piece of equipment with a rigid upward projection that may catch a rider's clothing

HELMETS: Properly fastened protective headgear must be worn at all times by all riders when mounted anywhere on show grounds. All headgear must meet or exceed ASTM standards, carry SEI tag and be properly fitted and secured by a harness.

DOGS: All dogs must be on a leash held in hand or confined.

CONCESSIONS: Concessions will be available with food and drinks. No credit cards accepted.

SPLIT/COMBINING CLASSES: All classes, except warm-ups and specialty classes, with 20 or more entries will be split. Classes 18" and under will be split at 16 entries. Classes may be combined at the manager's discretion. Junior/Amateur classes will not be combined with classes open to professionals and cannot exceed a 6" height difference.

LIMIT DIVISIONS: Limit divisions are open to riders who begin the show season without having won 5 blue ribbons over fences. After winning five (5) blue ribbons over fences the rider may continue to compete in this Division for the remainder of the show season. Warm up or Add Back blue ribbons will not count in the allowed Limit Blue Ribbons. Limit Riders may NOT show in any classes over 2'0 at this show.

CROSS ENTRIES: A horse/rider combination may cross enter only into divisions with fence heights of a 6" difference. Horse/rider combinations competing in 2' Open Hunter may not cross enter into 2' Jr/Am Hunter.
