ENTRIES: Entries must be emailed to sbfshows@gmail.com. There will be a post entry fee of \$25 per horse/rider entry if entered after April 3rd at 6:00 PM. No numbers will be issued without an open check & signed release.

CLASS FEES: Individual classes are \$25 each. Hunter Derby is \$55. Sunday Hunter Classic \$35

STALLS: Limited stabling available on a first come, first serve basis. Reservations can be made starting April 1st at 10:00am. Stalls are available Friday-Sunday and are \$100 with shavings included. Please contact Tracey at 214-402-6472 to reserve stalls.

SHOW FEES: \$25 office fee (\$15 office, \$10 scholarship) will be charged to for every horse & rider combination. EMT fee of \$10 per entry/per day. Any open checks not closed out at the end of the day will be charged a \$15 open check fee. A non-member fee of \$30 will apply to riders that are not members of NTHJC. Membership must be completed online at nthjc.com. Non-showing entries will be charged a \$50 schooling/EMT fee.

COGGINS: Proof of a negative Coggins (EIA) within one year is required by state law. No entry will be accepted without a Copy of the Original Coggins test which may be emailed to sbfshows@gmail.com with entries or presented to the show office upon arrival. Includes non-showing entries.

ARENAS: Ring 1: 135x250 covered arena with custom Kiser footing. Ring 2: 100x200 with sand footing. Warm-up areas are fenced grass paddocks.

SCHOOLING: Friday Schooling- Ticketed jumper course schooling in Ring 1. Hacking in both rings available- no EMT will be present. Saturday jumper schooling 7-7:45. Ticketed schooling may be available Saturday afternoon in both arenas once the courses are reset, time permitting. Sunday Ring 1 schooling 6:30-7:30am, Ring 2 schooling- daybreak to 7:45am.

AWARDS: All classes receive a first place Prize and 6 ribbons unless otherwise noted. A Champion ribbon & Prize and a Reserve Champion ribbon will be awarded for each division.

CONCESSIONS: Concessions will be available with food and drinks. No credit cards accepted.



ATTIRE: Formal show attire is required in all classes. Polo shirts are permitted in Jumpers.

HELMETS: Properly fastened protective headgear must be worn at all times by all riders when mounted anywhere on show grounds. All headgear must meet or exceed ASTM standards, carry SEI tag and be properly fitted and secured by a harness.

DOGS: All dogs must be on a leash held in hand or confined.

USHJA OUTREACH PROGRAM: This show will be recognized by USHJA Outreach and qualify for USHJA Outreach points for Zone 7. To read more about the USHJA Outreach program and get your free membership, visit their website at: https://www.ushja.org/competition/outreach

SPLIT/COMBINING CLASSES: All classes, except warm-ups and specialty classes, with 20 or more entries will be split. Classes 18" and under will be split at 16 entries. Classes may be combined at the manager's discretion. Junior/Amateur classes will not be combined with classes open to professionals and cannot exceed a 6" height difference.

LIMIT DIVISIONS: Limit divisions are open to riders who begin the show season without having won 5 blue ribbons over fences. After winning five (5) blue ribbons over fences the rider may continue to compete in this Division for the remainder of the show season. Warm up or Add Back blue ribbons will not count in the allowed Limit Blue Ribbons. Limit Riders may NOT show in any classes over 2'0 at this show.

CROSS ENTRIES: A horse/rider combination may cross enter only into divisions with fence heights of a 6" difference. Horse/rider combinations competing in 2' Open Hunter may not cross enter into 2' Jr/Am Hunter.
