Rules and Information

Note! We no longer keep Coggins or releases on file!

**Please bring Coggins and release forms WITH you to the registration desk!
DO NOT EMAIL!**

Bring Cash or Check to the registration desk to pay all rider and stall fees.

1. Please email all entries to hiddenlakefarm@gmail.com **Please do not text entries to Barbie's cell phone.**
2. The **entry fee is \$25 per class. After 10 pm Wednesday prior to the show**, a late fee of \$5 per class will apply, up to \$25, no exceptions.
There will be an office/ NTHJC scholarship fee of \$25 for each horse/rider combination, and a \$10 paramedic fee per horse/rider combination per day.
Fees are paid at the registration desk by either Cash or Check. We do not take Venmo or any credit card.
3. All children must be accompanied **and** supervised by an adult.
4. **Dogs must be kept on a leash held in hand at all times. For everyone's safety, aggressive dogs will not be tolerated. Management will require any dog that threatens people or other dogs to be removed from the property immediately.**
5. All adds and scratches must go through the desk, and **cannot be done at the gate. NOTE: Desk must be notified in a timely manner before rider enters the arena.**
6. There is only **one** warm-up class per fence height, and warm-up classes are open to all riders. **NOTE: It may be necessary to cancel one or more of the warm-up classes if there are so many entries in the show that our ability to complete every division becomes threatened.**
7. Riders must wear ASTM/SEI helmets at all times while mounted. Polo shirts with collar are only allowed in jumper classes.
8. Proof of a negative Coggins within one year is required by the State of Texas. Do not email Coggins or release forms with your registration, but instead bring Coggins report and rider release to the registration desk. A copy of Coggins on your phone is acceptable, but we must have a hard copy of your release form.
9. A horse/rider combination may only cross-enter into hunter divisions with fence heights of a 6" difference, except the limit divisions. This includes equitation flat and under saddle classes. Limit riders may not enter higher than 2'0 classes.
10. Management reserves the right to change, cancel, combine classes, alter courses, and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries.
11. Medal classes are open to all Jr/Amateur riders, but only NTHJC members are eligible to compete in the Year End Medal Finals.
12. Awards will include first thru sixth place ribbons for each class and Champion and Reserve ribbons for each division. The Equitation Over Fences, Equitation on the Flat, and NTHJC Medal Class will be considered a separate division at each height with Champion and Reserve ribbons awarded, provided all 3 classes are held.
13. Riders may pick up ribbons from the table close to the registration desk, and not at the gate. First place riders earn a prize from the first two tables, and champion winners may claim their prize from the two champion tables.
14. **Please note: Each rider must be a competing member of NTHJC. Membership fee is \$40.00 annually, and participants must register and pay online (NTHJC.com).**
