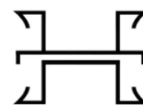

Show Rules & Information

Entries: Please submit entries via amec.horsespot.net. E-mailed entries will not be accepted. **Please submit entries by May 10.** A \$25 late fee will be applied on entries received after 11:59 PM May 12. **Please reserve your stalls and shavings via the barn account on Horse Spot.**

Class Fees: \$25 per class.

Stall Fees: \$100 each, from Friday – Sunday. Shavings: \$12/bag (3 minimum). Limited VIP Stalls are available for \$175. No outside shavings allowed. Early Move-In or Late Move-Out available for \$35 per night, including tack stalls. Please request early move-in with the show secretary either via the online entry form with your entries, or on your barn order.

Show Fees: A \$15 office fee and \$10 scholarship fee will be charged to each horse/rider combination. The \$15 office fee is nonrefundable after the May 12 closing date and will be charged to the credit card on file in case of a scratch. Each horse/rider combination will be charged an EMT fee of \$20. An EMT will be on the grounds during posted schooling and show times. An open check fee of \$15 will be charged for all accounts not closed at the show.

NTHJC Membership: All riders must be NTHJC Members for the 2026 season. Please join or renew your membership at horsespot.net/nthjcorq/o

Non-Showing Entries: Non-showing entries will be charged a \$40 schooling fee, in addition to show and stall or grounds fee. Non-showing entries are required to pay office, scholarship, and EMT fee. All horses on the grounds must be registered in the show office, provide coggins and vaccination proof, and receive a back number.

NTHJC Thoroughbred High Point Awards: Entry is free. TB registered name or tattoo # is required. Entry must be completed on nthjc.com prior to the completion of the show.

Health Records: Proof of a negative Coggins (EIA) within one year is required by state law. No entry will be accepted without a copy of the original Coggins. All horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhino) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Vaccination records include: documentation from veterinarian with name of given vaccinations and date. If given by other, receipt of purchase, name, serial #, expiration date, and date of administration. Please attach all health records to the online entry before check-in to avoid delays.

Schooling: There will be open schooling in all rings from Friday from 12:00 PM until 7:00 PM. Schooling prior to ring start according to the times posted on the schedule.

Limit Divisions: Limit divisions are open to riders who begin the show season without having won 5 blue ribbons over fences. After winning five (5) blue ribbons over fences, the rider may continue to compete in this division for the remainder of the show season. Warm up blue ribbons will not count in the allowed limit blue ribbons. Limit riders may NOT show in any class over 2'0 at this show.

Cross Entries: A horse/rider combination may cross enter only into divisions with fence heights of 6" difference. Trot Poles riders may only cross enter in Trot Crossrails. Trot Crossrails riders may only cross enter into Canter Crossrails. Canter Crossrails riders can cross enter into Trot Crossrails OR Short/Rusty Stirrup 18". Entries competing in 2' Open Hunter may not cross enter into 2' Jr/Am Hunter.

Awards: All classes receive a first place prize and 6 ribbons unless otherwise noted. A Champion ribbon & prize and a Reserve Champion ribbon will be awarded for each division.

Helmets: Properly fastened protective headgear must be worn at all times by all riders when mounted anywhere on show grounds. All headgear must meet or exceed ASTM standards, carry SEI tag, and be properly fitted and secured by a harness.

Dogs: All dogs must be on a leash held in hand or confined.

Concessions: Concessions will be available during show hours.

Arenas: Both arenas are 150' x 250' with sand footing.

Split Classes: All classes, except warm-ups and specialty classes, with 20 or more entries will be split. Classes 18" and under will be split at 16 entries.

Show Management: Management reserves the right to change, cancel, move, or combine classes and do all things necessary in the best interests of the horse show and its operations.

Warning: Under Texas law (Chapter 87, Civil, Practice & Remedies Code), an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

Responsibility Notice: Submission of entry to this show constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless NTHJC, Aubrey Meadows Equestrian Center, and show officials and management against any claim, demands, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fees for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of Exhibitor's business or its use of the premises or from any breach on the part of Exhibitors of any conditions of this Agreement, or contractors, agents, employees, guests, or invitees in or about the premises. In case of any action or proceeding brought against NTHJC, Aubrey Meadows Equestrian Center, and show management and officials by reason of any such claim. Exhibitor, upon notice, covenants to defend such action of proceeding by council acceptable to the owner. The exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property and NTHJC, Aubrey Meadows Equestrian Center, and show management are not responsible for accidents, fire, or theft.

Open to Amateur riders 18 years of age or older. Full course of 18" verticals. May be combined with Short Stirrup if entries warrant.

Short Stirrup 18" Hunter

Open to Junior riders under 18 years of age who have not won 5 blue ribbons over a figure eight course or placed in a class 2'3" or higher. Full course of 18" verticals. May only cross enter Short Stirrup Equitation and Limit Beginner 18" (WTC). May be combined with Rusty Stirrup if entries warrant.

Open 2'0" Hunter

Without Oxers. Open to all riders. Horse/Rider Combination may not cross enter into Jr/Am Hunter 2'0".
