Entries: Please submit entries and release form. Entries may be submitted via the link to the right. Enter online at <http://www.horseshowsonline.com>. **Entries are due by Monday, May 20th, A \$25 late fee will be applied on entries received after May 22nd.**

Class Fees: \$25 per class. Stalls: \$90. Shavings: \$11/Bag (3 Minimum) No outside shavings allowed **Fees:** Each horse/rider combination will be charged an EMT fee of \$10 per day. An EMT will be on grounds during posted schooling and show times. A \$15 office/\$10 NTHJC scholarship/benefit fee will be charged at \$25 per entry. An open check fee of \$15 will be charged for all accounts not closed at the show. Non-members of NTHJC will be charged a \$30 fee. NTHJC memberships can be paid online at NTHJC.com.

Stalls: Stalls will be available noon Friday through Sunday. No outside shavings are allowed. A 3 bag minimum is required.

Arenas: Both arenas are 150' x 250' with sand footing.

Schooling: There will be open schooling Friday from 1:00pm until 7:00 pm. Open schooling will be available Saturday & Sunday mornings from 6:30am until times stated on schedule. No jumper or Derby schooling. **Medal Classes:** Must follow the 6" cross entry rule when entering the Medal Classes. Open to all riders but only the top 8 point-earning members for the year will be invited to compete in the Medal Finals at the Year End Show. **Limit Divisions:** Limit divisions are open to riders who begin the show season without having won 5 blue ribbons over fences. After winning five (5) blue ribbons over fences the rider may continue to compete in this Division for the remainder of the show season. Warm up or Add Back blue ribbons will not count in the allowed Limit Blue Ribbons. Limit Riders may NOT show in any classes over 2'o at this show.

Cross Entries: A horse/rider combination may cross enter only into divisions with fence heights of a 6" difference. Walk Trot Poles may only cross enter in Walk Trot Crossrails. Walk Trot Crossrails may only cross enter into Limit Beginner 18".

Awards: All classes receive a first place Prize and 6 ribbons unless otherwise noted. A Champion ribbon & Prize and a Reserve Champion ribbon will be awarded for each division.

Attire: Proper show attire is required. Polo shirts with collars are allowed in Jumper Classes. No chaps allowed.

Helmets: Properly fastened protective headgear must be worn at all times by all riders when mounted anywhere on show grounds. All headgear must meet or exceed ASTM standards, carry SEI tag and be properly fitted and secured by a harness.

Dogs: All dogs must be on a leash held in hand or confined.

NTHJC Thoroughbred High Point Hunter & Jumper Awards: Entry is free. TB registered name or tattoo # is required. Entry forms available in show office. An entry form must be filled out at each NTHJC show. Year end points will be accrued and awarded at NTHJC Year End banquet.

Coggins: Proof of a negative Coggins (EIA) within one year is required by state law. No entry will be accepted without a Copy of the Original Coggins test which may be emailed to amy@equine-events.net with entries or presented to the show office upon arrival.

Concessions: Limited concessions will be available, please plan accordingly.

Split Classes: All classes, except warm-ups and specialty classes, with 20 or more entries will be split. Classes 18" or under will be split at 16 entries.

Warning: Under Texas law (Chapter 87, Civil, Practice & Remedies Code), an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

Responsibility: Submission of entry to this show constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Valhalla Stables and show officials and management against any claim, demands, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fees for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of Exhibitor's business or its use of the premises or from any breach on the part of Exhibitors of any conditions of this Agreement, or contractors, agents, employees, guests, or invitees in or about the premises. In case of any action or proceeding brought against Valhalla Stables and show management and officials by reason of any such claim. Exhibitor, upon notice, covenants to defend such action of proceeding by council acceptable to the owner. Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property and Valhalla Stables and Show management are not responsible for accidents, fire, or theft.

Management reserves the right to change, cancel, move or combine classes and do all things necessary in the best interests in the horse show and its operations.

Rusty Stirrup Hunter Division (USHJA Adult 18" Hunter)

Open to Amateur riders 18 years of age or older. Full course of 18" verticals.

10,11. Over Fences 12. Under Saddle

Short Stirrup Hunter Division (USHJA Junior 18" Hunter)

Open to Junior riders under 18 years of age who have not won 5 blue ribbons over a figure eight course or placed in a class 2'3" or higher. Full course of 18" verticals. May only cross enter into Short Stirrup Equitation and Limit Beginner Hunter 18".

13,14. Over Fences 15. Under Saddle

Open 2'0" Hunter Division (USHJA Open 2' Hunter)

Without Oxers. Open to all riders. Horse/Rider Combination may not cross enter into Jr/Am Hunter 2'0".

19. Over Fences 20. \$125 O/F Stake 21. Under Saddle

Junior/ Amateur 2'0" Hunter Division (USHJA Jr/Am 2' Hunter)

Without Oxers. Open to junior and amateur riders. Horse/rider combination may not cross enter into 2'0 Open Hunter.

22. Over Fences 23. \$125 O/F Stake 24. Under Saddle

Junior 2'3" Hunter Division (USHJA Junior 2'3 Hunter)

Open to junior riders.

28. Over Fences 29. \$125 O/F Stake 30. Under Saddle

Adult 2'3" Hunter Division (USHJA Amateur 2'3 Hunter)

Open to adult amateur riders.

31. Over Fences 32. \$125 O/F Stake 33. Under Saddle

Pony Hunter Division

Open to junior riders mounted on ponies. small 2'0, medium 2'3 & large 2'6.

37,38. Over Fences 39. Under Saddle 40. Pony Model

Pre-Green 2'6" Hunter Division

Open to horses and ponies in their first or second year of showing in any competition over fences. Open to all riders.

44,45. Over Fences 46. Under Saddle

Junior/ Amateur 2'6" Hunter Division (USHJA Jr/Ad 2'6 Hunter)

Open to junior and amateur riders.

47,48. Over Fences 49. Under Saddle

Low 2'9" Hunter Division (USHJA Open 2'9 Hunter)

Open to all riders.

Children/Adult 2'9" Hunter Division (USHJA Jr/Am 2'9 Hunter)

Open to junior and adult amateur riders.

EQUITATION DIVISIONS

Limit Equitation Poles (USHJA Walk-Trot Eq.)

Walk trot over ground poles, once around. Open to riders who have not won 5 blue ribbons over poles. 1,2.

Over Fences 3. On the Flat

Limit Equitation Crossrails (USHJA Walk-Trot Eq.)

Walk trot over crossrails, once around. Open to riders who have not won 5 blue ribbons over crossrails or poles.

4,5. Over Fences 6. On the Flat

Limit Beginner 18" (USHJA 18" Crossrails Eq.)

Walk trot canter over crossrails, twice around. Open to riders who have not won 5 blue ribbons at heights of 18" or higher.

7,8. Over Fences 9. On the Flat

Short Stirrup Equitation 18" (USHJA Junior 18" Eq.)

Open to Junior riders under 18 years of age. Full course of 18" verticals.

16. Over Fences 18. On the Flat

Junior/Amateur 2'0 Equitation (USHJA Jr/Am 2' Eq.)

Without Oxers. Open to junior and amateur riders. Horse/rider combination may enter into 2'0 Open Hunter or 2'0 Jr/Am Hunter, but not both.

25. Over Fences 26. Medal 27. On the Flat

Junior/ Amateur 2'3 Equitation (USHJA Jr/Am 2'3 Eq.)

Open to junior and amateur riders.

34. Over Fences 35. Medal 36. On the Flat

Pony Equitation 2'0, 2'3, 2'6

Open to junior riders mounted on ponies. small 2'0, medium 2'3 & large 2'6.

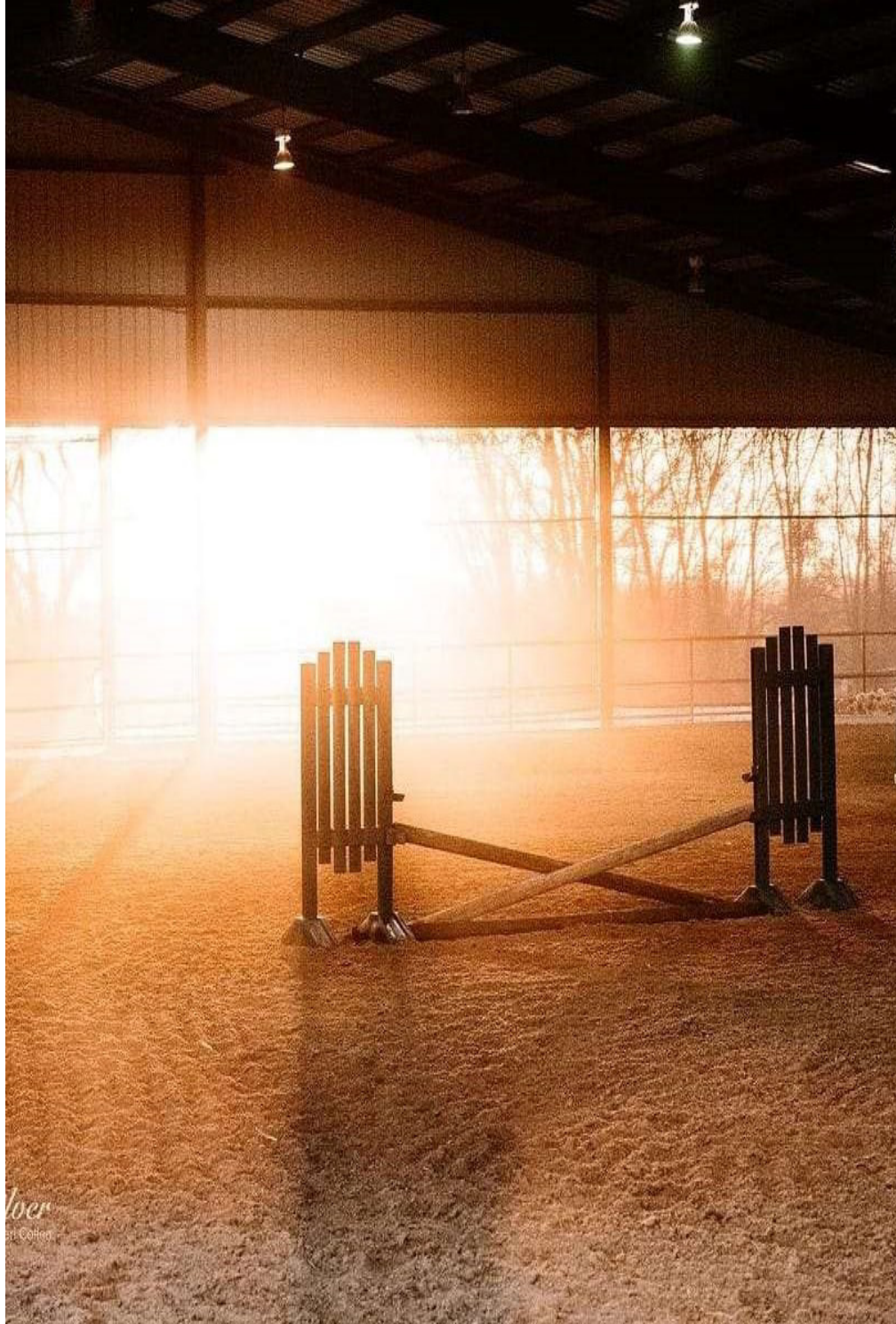

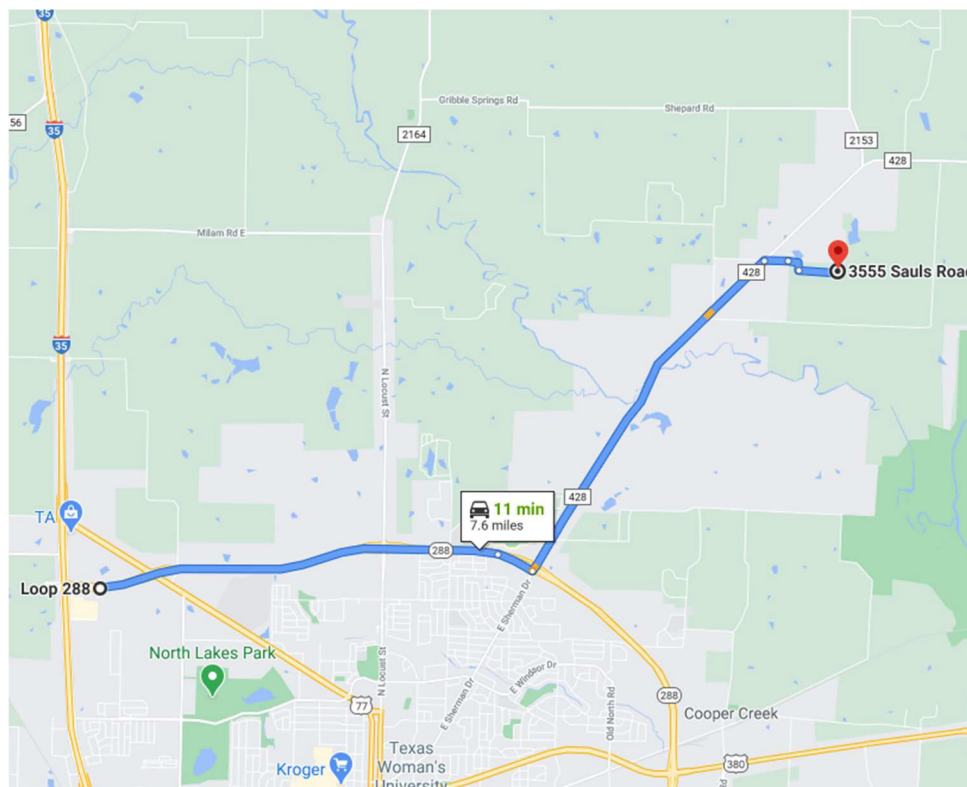
