Documentation from veterinarian with name of given vaccinations and date. If given by other, receipt of purchase, name, serial #, exp date and date of administration must be listed. All health records need to be attached to the online entry at www.Horsespot.net

ENTRIES: \$25.00 per class & \$25.00 Warm Up Classes (Before 6 PM Monday, 9/21/26)- NO EXCEPTIONS!!

There will be a post entry fee of \$25 per horse/rider entry if entered after 6:00 PM 9/21/26.

A non-refundable office fee of \$15 will be required for each entry- this fee will be charged to the credit card on file in case of a scratch. You will need to upload your credit card information.

ENTRY FORMS will not be accepted unless signed by the owner/authorized agent, rider and trainer. No numbers will be issued without an open check. Once the show has started, proper notification of the scratch must be made in the show office BEFORE the start of the class or classes being scratched or else the class fee may be charged. Please note barn affiliation on entry form and check.

COGGINS: Current coggins (dated within one year) must be uploaded to horsespot.net with your entries.

SCHOOLING: No schooling on Saturday. See Show schedule for schooling times for each ring.

FEES: \$25.00 office/benefit/scholarship fee will be charged for every horse & rider combination. \$10 EMT fee per entry, per day. A fee of \$15 may be charged for open checks not closed out by the end of the show.

PAYMENTS: You can pay online when checking out, but you will need to pay the convenience fees that the credit card will charge. We also accept checks and cash.

RETURNED CHECKS: A \$35.00 fee will be charged for all returned checks.

DOGS: There will be NO DOGS: NO Dogs are allowed on Prospering Farm property

ATTIRE: SEI APPROVED HELMETS MUST BE WORN BY ALL RIDERS WHILE MOUNTED. Riders must be properly attired – no chaps. Numbers must be worn and clearly visible.

RIBBONS, TROPHIES, and CHAMPIONSHIP: All classes receive a prize and 6 ribbons. All Divisions will be awarded Champion and Reserve ribbons using the standard tally system: 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, 0.5. In the event of a tie, management will break the tie by over fences points. Champion rosette and trophy will be awarded and Reserve rosettes. (Champion adds 10 points and Reserve adds 6 points)

CHANGES: Management reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes, alter courses, and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries. Divisions with less than 3 entries may be cancelled.

RESPONSIBILITY: Submission of entry to these shows constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Prospering Farm and NTHJC officials against any claim, demands, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fee for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of Exhibitor's business or its use of the premises or from any breach on the part of Exhibitors of conditions of this Agreement, or contractors, agents, employees, guests, or invitees in or about the premises. In case of any action or proceeding by council acceptable to owner. Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property and Prospering Farm and NTHJC Management is not responsible for accidents, fire, or theft.

MEMBERSHIP: All exhibitors must be a member of NTHJC before showing. NTHJC Memberships must be done online at www.nthjc.com.

STABLING: Limited stabling is available on a first come, first serve basis. \$75, including shavings. All stalls must be prepaid by Venmo @Susan-Horn-16. Prospering Farm is not responsible if you send your money by Venmo and you send it to the wrong person.

Limit Divisions: are open to riders who begin the show season without having won 5 blue ribbons over fences. After winning 5 blue ribbons over fences the rider may continue to compete in the division for the remainder of the show season. Limit Riders may NOT show in any classes over 2'0 at the same show. Riders will receive YEAR END AWARDS for the Limit Divisions!

CROSS ENTRIES: Horse/rider combination may cross enter only into divisions with fence heights of a 6" difference. Riders may not cross enter into 2' Jr/Am Hunter and 2' Open Hunter.

SPLIT CLASSES: All classes 2' & up, except warm-ups and specialty classes, with 20 or more entries will be split. Classes with fence heights of 18" or less will split at 16 entries.

NTHJC MEDAL CLASSES - The Medal Class will be open to all riders for the entire show season. The Top 8 NTHJC point earners for the year will be invited to compete in the Medal Finals at the Year End Show.

Prospering Farm will be offering the NTHJC High Point Thoroughbred Hunter & Jumper Awards.
